EMS Bureau Report: Rickey Stone SUIDS training will be placing materials on the list serve. NHTSA study we will be going to NREMT paramedic and EMT testing by 2016

Dr Joe – NREMT exam important on many levels, state directors working on licensure so it will be easier for EMS providers to move from state to state.

David Maatman – questioned if providers will have to maintain NREMT

Discussion followed with varying issues NEMSSO said initial exam, and provider would have to provide proof of having sat for NREMT, but providers maintain state cert.

Rickey Stone addressed Instructor rule which is still caught in the rule reduction process, it has been there for one year with no update.

Rickey is taking on a new rule within the bureau of EMS he asked that we be kind to his replacement.

Dr. Joe spoke to the Emergency Medical Boards and stated a 58% pass rate on the exam.

EMT/FIRE merger – There is a memorandum of understanding that EMT will be joined with state fire programs, for financial aid purposes.

Legislation is not in the best interest of either group. The program is supposed to just offer an additional option.

Chief Baker State Fire Marshall's office is not looking to replace current programs. It just allows grant opportunities.
